Every Patrol has the same size camp site, if there are trees on site or an odd shape that will be taken into account.

General advice is to place tents and dining fly at the edges, with the rope lines away from walkways. If the position and spacing is done well, then safety and defined pathways will also be done well.

Fire drums should be safe distance from tents.

Consider the placement of wet pit, garbage bin, washing up area, food preparation area.

### What is being judged.

#### Nutrition

A variety of healthy food types is looked for - meat/nuts, bread/potato/rice, fruit/vegetables. Fat and sugar/chocolate in moderation.

#### Difficulty

A balancing act here. Easy to prepare food well cooked is better than a complicated menu which fails to be delivered. As a guide, a bowl of cereal would be simple, bacon and egg cooked on a wood fire would be a bit of a challenge, eggs Benedict would be brave. When planning, be realistic about your Patrol's ability, you have to eat the result.

#### Presentation & Taste

People like different food. Here you are cooking for yourselves. If the Patrol likes the food and it is nutritious, then you have succeeded. If the visiting Leader also likes the food, you have done well.

#### Timing

Requires practice & planning. On time is within 15 minutes of scheduled time.

#### Washing Up Water

Hot water should be ready when needed

#### Meal time hygiene

Hands clean, food safely handled. No-one wants food poisoning.

#### Grace, harmony, morale

Is the Patrol happy and enjoying the food, helping when needed?

#### Cooking on a wood fire

Adds difficulty, the flame needs to be watched.

#### Difficulty

Number of lashings required, complexity of design

#### Execution

Appropriate lashings and knots used, correctly and firmly tied and neatly finished off.

#### Usefulness

Useable for its function

#### Design

Simple functional design is sometimes all that is needed, but for gateways originality can get extra points. Considered use of available materials will score better than using made for purpose components.

As an indication of the standard expected, for a flagpole:

A stick hammered into the ground or tied to a star picket would get 0-5 points

2 lashed poles with 3 guy ropes and a lanyard would get 10-15 points

Suspended flagpole of lashed poles would get 20-25 points
